If you are coming from Beaumont on I-10, take Exit 869/Hwy 1442 South and travel approximately 5 miles to the intersection of Hwy 105. Turn left on FM 105 and go approximately 2 miles. The church will be just past the high school campus.

If you are coming from Beaumont on I-10, you can also take Hwy 62 South and travel approximately 4 miles to the intersection of Hwy 105. Turn right on FM 105 and go approximately 2 miles. The church will be on the right just past the intersection of FM 105 and 408.

From Port Arthur , take Hwy 87 to Bridge City . In the center of Bridge City , turn left on Roundbunch Road (Hwy 1442). Proceed approximately 1 ½ miles to the intersection of hwy 408 on right. Stay on 408 to intersection of FM 105. Turn left on FM 105. Continue approximately ¼ mile. The church will be on the right.
