Hazel Hall gave the music report. She reported that there would be an extra Christmas music practice at the Faske's house on October 12, about 6:30 P.M. She also mentioned the play at Heritage Village in Woodville on October 16. November 12 at 5 P.M. there will be soup and jamming at Floyd and Bobbie Boyett's house in Kountze. The syrup making festival will be the next day on November 13. Keith Faske had nothing new to report on the webpage. There was no old business. Under new business, Steve asked for volunteers for a nominating committee. Suellen Weaver, Mary Beth Hunt, and Hazel Hall were approved for that committee. Darrell Hall made a motion to donate \$400 to Rosedale Baptist. It was seconded by Suellen, and passed. Keith suggested doing a fundraiser at Sam's club for Luke Juda's granddaughter. There was some discussion about this or cooperating with a church. Keith will research and report at the next meeting. The meeting was adjourned.
